IT COULD SAVE YOUR LIFE!

#### "Christian Life Begins at Baptism"

*Merry Christmas!* If you were puzzled at this greeting, then you either have forgotten or don't know that it's still Christmas Season. *Yes, it's true!* The secular celebration of **Christmas** (a/k/a, the "holidays"!), because it is geared toward buying and selling, begins well before Thanksgiving, with earlier hints in September and October. Come Christmas Day the secular observance of the season comes to a screeching halt. On December 26<sup>th</sup>, many Christmas trees are found lying on the street curbs and the newspapers are filled with tempting "*After-Christmas Sales*", again directed to buying and selling!

Holy Mother Church always has the better way, and it's the way to follow if we work to prevent ourselves from being swallowed up by the secular way of celebrating which is often intense and unrelenting. The Christmas Season begins with the Vigil of Our Lord's Nativity, is celebrated for eight solemn days (Octave of Christmas), continues with the Feasts of Mary, Mother of God, the Holy Name of Jesus, the Epiphany of Our Lord, and closes with the Baptism of Jesus by St. John the Baptist.

The Feast of Our Lord's Baptism fittingly reminds us of an important fact. Jesus was baptized, not because He needed baptism. He is, after all, the **Son of God, Second Person of the Most Blessed Trinity.** Jesus permitted His baptism by His cousin John in the River Jordan ("It is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness." Cf.: Matthew 3:15-17) to give us an example of the importance of that sacrament in the life of every Christian. Along with the Catholic Church, nearly every Christian denomination outside the Church celebrates Baptism. Those baptisms are valid, so that even if one converts from another Christian faith to Catholicism, Baptism is not repeated. The Sacrament of Baptism is so vital that, in an emergency situation when no priest or deacon (the ordinary, valid ministers of the sacrament) are available, any lay person can baptize.

The Christmas Season is certainly one of fellowship. Except for the unrepentant *Ebeneezer Scrooge or the Grinch*, no one really wants to be alone at Christmastime. We come together to honor Our Lord's Nativity with family and friends, some of whom we've not seen in a long time. It's an inclusive season, Baptism, too, is inclusive. Not only does the sacrament wash away original sin (inherited from the sin of our first parents Adam and Eve), it makes us a member of Christ's Church. Christians should never feel alone or unloved. It was for each of us that the Word became flesh, God became a man and lived among us. He shared our human condition in all things but sin. He gave His life for us in order that we might all be together again with Him in the eternal Kingdom of light and beauty and truth and goodness and love. Baptism is important. *It's vital*. It brings us together in Christ.

So, once more: *Merry Christmas!* Enjoy and thank God for this blessed season.
