## “What His First Miracle Teaches”

In the ordinary form of the Mass (**Missal of Paul VI**), the Sunday readings revolve in a three-year cycle, while the extraordinary form (**Missal of blessed John XXIII**) uses an annual cycle of readings. In the *Second Sunday after Epiphany* of the extraordinary form, the **Gospel of the Wedding at Cana** is always read. But every three years, the ordinary and extraordinary forms coincide when that same Gospel on this Sunday of the second week in Ordinary Time is used. With his Apostolic Letter, *Rosarium Virginis Mariae* (*RVM*, October 16, 2002), the Servant of God **John Paul II** enhanced the beautiful devotion of the **Holy Rosary** by adding the luminous, or “*mysteries of light*” to the familiar and venerable joyful, sorrowful and glorious mysteries. “[*The Rosary*] represents a most effective means of fostering among the faithful that commitment of the Christian mystery,” the late Holy Father writes. Addressing the new mysteries, he reminds us that, “*each of these [luminous] mysteries is a revelation of the Kingdom now present in the very person of Jesus.*” (*RVM*, #5, #21)

A little farther in that section, Pope John Paul II addresses the **second luminous mystery**; “*Another mystery of light is the first of the signs, given at Cana (cf.: John 2:1-12), when Christ changes water into wine and opens the hearts of the disciples to faith, thanks to the intervention of Mary, the first among believers.*” (*RVM*, #21)

The Church recommends that the luminous mysteries be prayed on Thursdays, but they may be prayed on any day. This day is most appropriate, since we hear the story of the Wedding at Cana, upon which the second luminous mystery is based.

From that event in the Gospel of John we may derive two important considerations for our contemplation. *First*, it was at the request of **Our Blessed Mother Mary** that Jesus performed His first public miracle by changing the water into wine, thus preventing embarrassment for the newly married couple. Mary’s role is to lead us to Jesus, and we may confidently ask her intercession for any need. Like any good mother, she always brings our prayer requests, *if they be for our good*, to her son Jesus.

*Second*, **it was no coincidence that the first miracle Jesus performed occurred at a wedding.** Perhaps more important than a demonstration of His power, Our Lord was emphasizing the sacred institution of marriage by His presence there. This is crucial, especially in our times. Our confused world, under the deluded and emotionally-charged argument of equal “rights,” continues to attack marriage by trying to redefine what it has been know to be for millennia *among all cultures, religions and civilizations*; **the union of one man and one woman**, open to the procreation of the human race. Jesus’ miracle at Cana proved that He *must* be present in each marriage. If the husband and wife leave no room for Him, the marriage will suffer. When Our Lord is included, it doesn’t mean a marriage won’t have difficulties. But those storms can be weathered and overcome by turning to Jesus and the rededication of the couple’s commitment to each other in good and bad times (just as the marriage vows proclaim).
