## “Finding Peace in Prayer on Easter”

As happens every year, most of us are consumed with busyness on this **Easter Day**. Hopefully that activity begins with the **Holy Sacrifice of the Mass**. As each Sunday is celebrated as a “little Easter,” how can any Catholic forego the **Feast of the Resurrection** itself? It is **more than another “holiday,”** this most important of days in the Church liturgical calendar. For if Jesus had never risen from the dead, His Church would never have continued for two centuries and more. If Jesus had never risen, then our lives are truly without meaning. How comforting for us Christians to know and believe that beyond this earthly, temporary, often painful existence, beyond the passage of death, a new, enduring life awaits for those who are faithful to the Lord’s promises.

Easter is the culmination of many details, from housecleaning to preparing the food, to traveling here and there. So after assisting at Easter Sunday Mass, the activities continue, principally the Easter dinner, perhaps with family members and friends we rarely see. By Easter evening, when two disciples walked along the road to Emmaus with the risen Jesus (whom they did not recognize at first), most of us are probably too exhausted to walk from one room to another, let alone make a journey of some miles.

But when you finally do sit down, what a wonderful moment to **rest** and to **pray** for our priests, for our seminarians in formation (both diocesan and religious life), and for an increase in vocations to the priesthood. A simple but effective prayer is the Rosary.

On Laetare Sunday, we presented the Sorrowful Mysteries from a **Rosary for Priest**. On this most glorious of days, the rising of Jesus Christ from the tomb, the triumph of death over life, we offer meditations on the Glorious Mysteries from that same version of the Rosary. These are especially appropriate in this **Year for Priests**.

**The Resurrection** ~ At times, priests may suffer from depression and despair. We pray that priests will remember: the Crucifixion is followed by the Resurrection; darkness is always followed by light. May all priests share the joy of the Risen Christ.

**The Ascension** ~ We pray that priests may carry out Jesus’ instruction to evangelize the whole world, instructing and baptizing countless souls.

**The Descent of the Holy Spirit** ~ We pray the priests may be open to the graces of the Holy Ghost to strengthen them for the task of bringing souls to God and God to souls. May priests be on fire to convert the most hardened sinners.

**The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary** ~ We pray the priests will be devoted to Mary and find in her the love and comfort of a mother, the most powerful intercession of our greatest Saint, and the surest refuge against Satan and his cohorts who seek the destruction of priests and the priesthood.

**The Coronation of the Blessed Virgin Mary** ~ We pray that Mary, Queen of the Clergy, will be their model of faith and joy, and constant guide until they reach Heaven where a crown, jeweled with the many souls entrusted to them on the day of their ordination, will be their reward for faithful and loving service.

**Queen of Heaven, rejoice, Alleluia!**
