“All in Need of Mercy.”

Last week we introduced personal responsibility and forgiveness. Nowadays, people seem willing to accept responsibility...only if it's in their favor. But too often when one is truly guilty, the first urge is to point the finger away, toward something or someone else that might have influenced the outcome. Probably one of the reasons that so few Catholics confess their sins anymore is because they prefer “self-absolution.” If in your mind somebody else is always to blame, why bother seeking forgiveness? This leads to another problem: the less we seek forgiveness, the less likely we forgive others.

The sexual abuse of minors by a minority of clergy and religious in the Catholic Church is a horrendous sin and crime. This is a clear fact, and there should be no disagreement here. Unlike “no fault divorce” or “no fault insurance,” there is blame (and shame) to be assigned to the guilty parties, and rightly so. But, as in many other instances in life, we can take situations, stretch and twist them into extremes.

There have been and continue to be many non-Catholics who point out the sins and faults of the Catholic Church. They are joined by many Catholics who readily assign blame as well. This demonstrates their agreement with Our Lord on the evil of sin.

True victims of sexual abuse deserve compassion and care. But when an offender has admitted guilt and expresses true contrition for his sins, are we willing to forgive that offender as Jesus teaches? Our Lord experienced anger: at the money-changers in the Temple; at the Pharisees' hypocrisy; at those who would manipulate or use children. But He never taught revenge and promoted retaliation. If He had, He would never have suffered such an ignominious death on the Cross. Those who continuously attack the Church and pointing out her grievous errors may be righteous in their anger, like those with the adulterous woman. But so many of them fail to take the next step. **They are unwilling to forgive.** They conveniently forget---or deny--- that they, too, are sinners; hopefully not engaging in sexual abuse, but sinners nevertheless. No other human but Our Blessed Lady is without sin. We mustn't forget Our Lord's words after the departure of those who wanted to stone the adulterous woman. Jesus forgives her, with a warning: **“Neither do I condemn you. Go, and do not sin anymore.” (cf.: John 8:11)**

In many situations, we need to grow up. There is justifiable anger; there is cause to point out the errors of others. But perpetuating anger and revenge never solves anything. A terrorist must certainly always be angry. When one has personally erred, it's best to admit it, accept the responsibility and try to make corrections where possible.

Even in the case of grave sins like sexual abuse, the authentic Christian must be willing to forgive, to show compassion. That's difficult. It's much easier to point the blame. The Lord's Prayer does not say, *“forgive us our sins, as we so easily forgive others.”* Jesus never said it would be easy to forgive. It may take a long time to do so. But Jesus does teach us that **it is the right thing to do**, the only way to go forward.
