“Most Important Resolutions.”

On this second day of the calendar year, since it is a Sunday in 2011, the U.S. Church is celebrating the Solemnity of the **Epiphany of Our Lord**. Since 1970, when not observed as a holyday of obligation, this Feast of the **Three Kings’** visit to the Baby Jesus is observed on the first Sunday of the new year. Falling only one day after the Solemnity of **Mary, the Mother of God**, we wish you a very **Happy New Year!**

We hope you are still enjoying the **Christmas Season**, because that is precisely where we are. We are aware that by now, a large segment of society has “*washed its hands*” of Christmas, or, to use their preferred slogan, “*the holidays*.” They’re already focused on the next opportunity to profit, i.e., Valentine’s Day. **IGNORE THEM!** Continue greeting each other with “*Merry Christmas!*” and “*Happy New Year!*” in these joy-filled days. With this in mind, we offer two important resolutions that are worth trying to keep.

If we haven’t been doing so, we should try to **follow the Church calendar and adapt** our lives/schedules **to it**, rather than allow the secular world to dictate to us. From December 25th, the **Nativity of Our Lord**, the Church gives us so many beautiful customs and feasts. The eight days until January 1st are the **Octave of Christmas**, and our celebrations during those days include the Feasts of **St. Stephen**, the **Holy Innocents**, and **St. John the Apostle**. The traditional “*Twelve Days of Christmas*,” of course, run from the Lord’s Birth until January 6th. Christmastide lasts until the Feast of the **Baptism of Our Lord**. Unofficially, the season is observed until **Candlemas Day**, February 2nd. On that day we commemorate the **Presentation of the Infant Jesus** at forty days old in the temple, as well as the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The second resolution may not be easy, but it’s certainly worth following in this unfolding year. Above all else in your life, make the goal of heaven your major focus. Let this be your most fervent prayer: “**Lord, I want to be with You forever in eternity!**” No problem, you might say. *Why wouldn’t I want to go to heaven, considering the alternative?* But it’s not a free ride; we must work at it by doing our part. Yes, God invites each of us to be with Him forever, but He never forces us. There are plenty of obstacles in our way, and the great deceiver and liar, Satan, not only wants us to stumble off the right path; he wants us to permanently detour onto the wrong road. The illusions and seductions of the contemporary world are powerful and potentially deadly diversions. So everything and *everyone* in your life must be secondary to your heavenly goal.

But this sounds too selfish, you argue. For example, *how can I* (a spouse and/or parent) *ignore my spouse and/or children?* The Lord isn’t asking us to treat those we love with indifference or disrespect. Rather, He wants us to keep the correct perspective. When all is said and done, at the end of life, each of us will stand alone before our Maker. Any restlessness that we experience in this life is simply a reminder that we won’t be completely happy and satisfied until we are again with Him Who created us. So while we go about our daily lives and tasks, let us keep God front and center, and do what He asks of us. “**Lord, I want to be with You forever in eternity! Let nothing or no one deter me. I trust that, cooperating with Your grace, I will achieve heaven!**”
