“Far from Ordinary.”

On this commemoration of the **Baptism of Our Lord** we gain some insights on the importance of both this sacrament and participation as Catholics at Sunday Mass.

Then and now, the Baptism of Our Lord gives us a glimpse of our Triune God, the **Most Blessed Trinity: Father** (Whose voice is heard), **Son** (Jesus Who is baptized by His cousin John), and **Holy Spirit** (Who soars overhead in the form of a dove).

Though most of us don't remember it, the Baptism of Jesus should remind us of our baptism. Through this sacrament, original sin is washed away and we become members of the Body of Christ, His Church. In one of his homilies, **Pope Benedict XVI** called baptism the *“bridge [Jesus] built between Himself and us, the road on which He makes Himself accessible to us....the door of hope and....the sign that indicates to us the path to take actively and joyfully to encounter Him.”* (Baptism of Lord, Jan. 11, 2009)

Today is the final day of the Christmas Season in the Church's liturgical calendar. Tomorrow we begin part one of the **“season through the [Church] year”** (from the Latin, *“per annum”*) in these weeks following the Epiphany. In English translation, this period (along with the second part which begins after Pentecost) has been given the unfortunate misnomer of “Ordinary Time.” In the calendar of the extraordinary (a/k/a Tridentine) form of Mass we have a better designation for this period: the Sundays are numbered **“after Epiphany”** (the second half is named, **“after Pentecost”**). The Sundays in the Anglican Church's calendar continue to be designated in this way.

Calling something ordinary may give the impression of unimportance, routine, even boredom. Too many Catholics are apathetic in their respect for Sunday, lulled into further complacency in the practice of their faith. It's erroneous to think that now there's nothing “special” in the Church until Easter, thus giving ourselves “permission” to skip Mass on an “Ordinary Sunday” and treat it like any other day. *“So what if I miss Sunday Mass? After all, there'll just be another ‘ordinary’ one next week.”* Significant damage has already been done to Sunday as a day set apart. This must not continue.

While we may think we know the Mass and Church liturgical year well enough, nothing about the Mass and Church Year should ever be considered routine. Each week begins with the Lord's Day, the day on which He rose from the dead, and that is anything but ordinary; *it's miraculous!* The Lord gives us His risen Body and Blood in every Mass. *That is mystery and miracle!* Can we honestly see this as boring or excusable?

Personal tasks and schedules acquire a certain routine. Yet the next day is never an exact copy of the previous one. In that same homily referenced above, our Holy Father says *“the Baptism of Jesus introduces us into the daily regularity of a personal relationship with Him.”* Rather than in extraordinary circumstances, it's in our everyday routines that we may recognize our Lord awaiting us, if we permit and welcome Him.

As baptized members of the Church, we need to make time for regular encounters with the Lord. Going to Sunday Mass and setting aside the rest of the day from the mundane ensures that there'll never be anything “ordinary” about that day.
