# FIFTY QUESTIONS ON THE ORDER OF MASS

## A Brief Examination of Practice

These brief reflections are about developing good habits. Habits of fidelity to the liturgical books of the Roman Rite. They are based upon a conviction that only through fidelity to the Church's liturgical texts and rites can we bring about an effective *Ars Celebrandi*, an art of celebrating the sacred liturgy with authenticity.

### INTRODUCTORY RITES

#### #1 ~ Should the Priest sing during the Entrance Procession

According to the Bishops of the United States, "The importance of the priest's participation in the Liturgy, especially by singing, cannot be overemphasized," and the priest should encourage others to sing is "by his own example, joining in the congregational song."

#### #2 ~ Should the priest sing into the microphone?

The priest should never sing into the microphone, drowning out the rest of the Church. Thus, the Bishops advise that "while the assembly sings, the priest should step back from a microphone, or, if he is using a wireless microphone, he should turn it off."

#### #3 ~ If there's a tabernacle behind the Altar, do we genuflect or bow?

If there's a tabernacle in the sanctuary the bow to the Altar is replaced by a genuflection upon arriving at and departing from the sanctuary.

#### #4 ~ Can I make both a bow and a genuflection?

No. If the tabernacle is in the sanctuary, the priest and ministers genuflect. If there is no tabernacle in the sanctuary, they bow. They never do both.

#### #5 ~ If a tabernacle is located in the sanctuary, is it revered during the rest of the Mass?

A genuflection is made as the procession approaches and departs from the altar, "but not during the celebration of Mass itself."

#### #6 ~ Can the priest do the introductory rites from the Altar?

No, after he venerates the altar the priest goes to the chair.

#### #7 ~ When the priest greets the people, is there a gesture?

Yes, when he greets the people he extends his hands.

#### #8 ~ Can the priest introduce the Mass with a few words after the greeting?

Yes. "The Priest, or a Deacon, or another minister, may very briefly introduce the faithful to the Mass of the day." It should be noted that these words are very brief.
