## FIFTY QUESTIONS ON THE ORDER OF MASS

A Brief Examination of Practice

These brief reflections are about developing good habits. Habits of fidelity to the liturgical books of the Roman Rite. They are based upon a conviction that only through fidelity to the Church's liturgical texts and rites can we bring about an effective *Ars Celebrandi*, an art of celebrating the sacred liturgy with authenticity.

(Continued from last week)

### **#21 ~ How many swings of the thurible are used for incensation?**

Three swings for the Blessed Sacrament, a relic of the Cross, images of the Lord, the offerings, the altar cross, the Book of the Gospels, the paschal candle, the Priest, and the people; two swings for relics and images of the Saints exposed for public veneration.

### **#22 ~ When the Gospel is proclaimed, is there a gesture with "The Lord be with you."**

No. this is the one time in the Mass when "The Lord be with you" is said without extending the hands.

### **#23 ~ In a concelebration, does the Deacon bring the book of the Gospels to the priest to kiss and give a blessing?**

If the celebrant is a priest, the deacon alone kisses the book of the Gospels. If the celebrant is a bishop, the deacon may bring the Book of the Gospels to him so that the Bishop can kiss and give a blessing with it.

## THE HOMILY

### **#24 ~ From where can the homily be given?**

A priest may preach standing at the chair (only a Bishop may preach while seated) or at the ambo or at another worthy place.

### **#25 ~ At the words "and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man" who should bow?**

All bow during these words.

### **#26 ~ Can the Apostles Creed be used instead of the Nicene Creed?**

Yes. Either creed may be used.

### **#27 ~ Is a bow required during the Nicene Creed?**

Yes. During the words "and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man," the priest and people make a profound bow.
