Divine Mercy Parish Council Meeting - November 20, 2012 Minutes

Opening Prayer: Led by Fr. Stefan

Attendance: 18 Present; 2 Absent (T. Smola, C. Mastalarz); 5 Excused (J. Brozek, B. Gallagher, McDougal, L. McKee, T. Schultz)

Minutes of previous meeting (April 17) were read and accepted.

OLD BUSINESS: The roof on the grotto has not been repaired (it is not leaking). The Communion Breakfast, with guest speaker on Question 2, was a success. The speaker was excellent. Diane Baldyga received no new volunteers for lectoring. Luke Roberts is working on plaques with the English text for the Stations of the Cross in the Church. Deb Ingalls published a list of the parish council members in the bulletin, as well our last minutes. STAR raffle response is not as great as last year, but it is still a good fundraiser. Lotto Calendars have already gone out. There will be another election for Parish council in the spring. Volunteers were sought to have their terms end, and to re-run in the Spring. Donald Frydryk, Diane Baldyga, Fred Orszulak and Paul Laflamme volunteered. Our next meeting will be Tuesday, April 3, unless something important comes up before then.

NEW BUSINESS: The high school CCD class would like to put on a breakfast to benefit the Covenant House, as well as a student from the class who is planning to go to Haiti on school vacation with a diocesan youth ministry organization. A parishioner complained about the sidewalk aside the Church, and how there is a 'lip' that is a trip hazard. Father will ask a contractor if it can be addressed. However, with change in temperature, the sidewalk sections rise and fall. The issue of lighting outside the school, after events, was addressed. There are lights, but not everyone knows how to turn them on and off. Fred suggested aiming a light between the school and the parking lot. The sign from St. Anne's has been put in the parking lot, but nothing has been put on it. Father will take care of that. John Yurkunas suggested posting in the bulletin the reason why Catholics should genuflect before the altar, perhaps under a heading "The ABC's of Being Catholic". A discussion was held about Adult Education, and the reception of Communion at the altar (and not taking the host back to your pew).

Motion was made to adjourn - seconded and passed.

Closing prayer was led by Father Stefan.

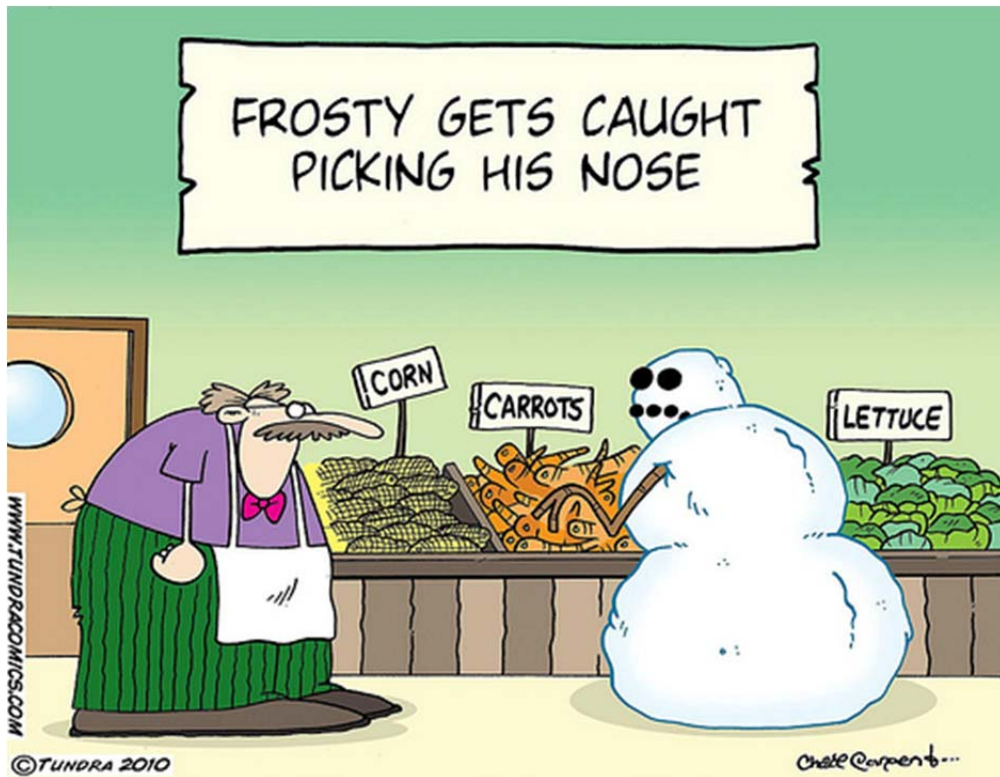
