**PRO-LIFE NEWS FOR NOVEMBER 10, 2013** ~ According to NPR, the O-care website, Healthcare.gov, does not have any information on what plans do or do not cover abortion. Cong. Chris Smith (R-NJ) has filed a bill that would address O-care's secrecy clause by requiring health plans to disclose whether they cover abortion. Cardinal Sean O'Malley, Chair of the USCCB's Committee on Pro-Life Activities, wrote a letter to Congress: *"H.R. 3279 does not affect the Affordable Care Act's underlying abortion problem, which is the subject of other legislation we support such as the No Taxpayer Funding for Abortion Act (H.R. 7)...The new bill addresses only this unprecedented policy of government-enforced secrecy. Health plans will have to report on their coverage of abortion, and on the extra payment they charge to cover abortions. Only then will Americans be enabled to make an informed choice of a health plan for themselves and their families that does not violate their moral and religious convictions. This should be a point of agreement between lawmakers who consider themselves both 'pro-life' and 'pro-choice.' Any claim of 'choice' is empty if the law conceals the facts needed to make that choice. Please co-sponsor H.R. 3279 and help enact it into law."* You can send this same message to your Congressmen from Massachusetts Citizens for Life's website, or you can contact them by phone or email.
