May is just around the corner, and is a month dedicated to Mary, the Mother of God. When you are out walking, riding your bicycle, or driving through neighborhoods, do you take notice of the statues of our Blessed Mother? We have a tradition that when you pass by a statue of Mary, pick someone you know who could use your prayers, and say a Hail Mary for them. It's a powerful prayer, and Her statue is a great reminder to pray for our friends and relatives in need of her intercession. If you would like to put a statue of Mary in your yard, but think it's too expensive, or don't know where to get one, we found a beautiful statue (34 inches tall!) that looks like granite, but is actually durable, heavy-duty resin (you fill it with sand for weight) for under \$55.00 (and free shipping!). Go to Amazon.com, type in "Outdoor Mary Statue", and look for the one from Emsco Group 2290. If you would like a statue, but don't know how to order from Amazon, we would be happy to order one for you, and you could pick it up at the rectory or in Ludlow. Just call Dick and Barbara Kelleher at 413-531-9630. But you don't need a statue of your own to acknowledge Our Lady. When you pass by her statue, just say a quick Hail Mary. Every little prayer is heard and answered!
